- Impactful, life-saving support


When asked about what the community would like to see from HAND in 2025, the thematic responses were:


- Grow Outreach and Advocacy:

 - (3) Stillparents, TFMR
- Fellowship activities, primarily in-person (e.g., hiking, crafts)
